V.I.C. Title. 23 CH-9, § 871, § 610 & § 872

Bonfires and outdoor rubbish fires - Permit required.

(a) No person shall kindle or maintain any bonfire or rubbish fire or authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintain on or in any public street, alley, road or other public ground without or other proper authorization.

Location restricted.

- (b) No person shall kindle or maintain any bonfire or rubbish fire or authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintain on any private land unless (1) the location is not less than 50 feet from any structure and adequate provision is made to prevent fire from spreading to within 50 feet of any structure or (2) the fire is contained in an approved waste burner with closed top, located safely not less than 15 feet from any structure.
- (c) The Director may prohibit any or all bonfires and outdoor rubbish fires when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous.

Whoever – Violates any provision of this chapter or any regulations order issued under this chapter for which a penalty is not otherwise provided – shall be fined not more than \$500.00 or imprisoned not more than one year, or both.

Kindling Fire on land of another

No person shall kindle a fire upon the land of another without permission of the owner thereof or his agent.
